

ESCAPED.

FROM the *Town Gaol, Cambridge*, about a quarter before 6 o'clock yesterday evening the 18th inst. **WILLIAM GROOM**, alias **CONNOR** or **LACEY**, aged 30 years, 5 feet 8½ inches high, born in Queen's County, Ireland, dark brown hair, grey eyes, dark eyebrows and lashes, common mouth, rather fresh complexion, round visage, nose has been broken, by trade a mariner, (he calls himself a tailor,) scar on fore finger of left hand, and on little finger of left hand. He is under sentence of transportation for seven years, is a notorious character, and has been transported before.

Whoever shall apprehend him and lodge him in any of his Majesty's gaols; shall receive **FIVE GUINEAS REWARD**; and all reasonable expences, by application to **Mr. JOHN PAYNE**, Keeper of the Gaol for the Town of Cambridge.
