DOUBLE TAKE PROJECTION

As soon as the sun sets, Second Court will be illuminated by the highlight of the night. Double Take Projections, renowned for their work on many famous landmarks, have created a beautiful display to enchant the evening. Inspired by the stories told by the skies, look through the telescope into a journey of astronomical proportions.

The projection pays tribute to John Flamsteed (1646-1719), an alumnus of Jesus College, Cambridge who dedicated his life to astronomy. He was the first Astronomer Royal, known also for preparing a 3000-star catalogue, Catalogus Britannicus, and a star atlas called Atlas Coelestis, and being the first to make recorded observations of Uranus.

Second Court will be strewn with stars, constellations, astronomical clocks, and of course, a gauzy aurora. This is the largest scale visual masterpiece of light and animation that Jesus College has ever seen, so make sure to return to it throughout the night to catch its every moment.
