separate use and to be free from the control debts or interference of her present or any future husband and so as she should not be deprived of the benefit thereof by any mode of anticipation and from and after her decease upon trust as to the said Capital stock funds and securities for all and every the said and children of the said Mary Anna Stewart by her late or present husband who shall attain twenty one year of age equally to be divided between and amongst them absolutely as tenants in common and I hereby empower my said trustees for the time being to apply all or any part of the dividends interest or annual product of the presumptive or expectant share of each said child after the decease of the said Mary Anna Stewart during minority towards and or her maintenance and education or otherwise for and or her benefit and to accumulate the residue if any and I further empower them to apply forth the receipt of the said Mary Anna Stewart during her life and after her decease at her own direction any part not exceeding one third of the principal of the share or respective shares of each or any of said children towards and or her advancement or preferment in the world or otherwise for and or her benefit as they may deem proper provided always and I do hereby declare that if the said Archibald Stewart or Charles Frederick Stewart or either of them or any future trustee or trustees to be hereby appointed shall depart this life or become incapable or unwilling to act in the trusts of this my will it shall be lawful for the survivor of them and after the decease of both of them their executors or administrators of the survivor or for the surviving or remaining trustee for the time being within three months from next events respectively to nominate and appoint a new trustee or trustees in the room of the one or both so dying or becoming incapable or unwilling to act respectively after the appointment of such new trustee or trustees respectively the said trust estate and effects shall be vested in and transferred to the new trustee jointly with the surviving or remaining trustee or in such new trustees solely as the said may be and that the said new trustee or trustees shall have the same powers as the trustee or trustees in whose place they shall be so appointed I nominate and appoint the said Archibald Stewart and Charles Frederick Stewart to be Executors of this my will and hereby revoke all former wills by me at any time heretofore made do hereby publish and declare this to be my last will and testament in witness whereof I the said Judith Campbell the testatrix have to this my last will and testament set my hand this twentieth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight — J.
